



## Residency Appeal

In order to receive the Peoria Promise scholarship, you must live in Peoria and continue to live in Peoria to remain eligible. While enrolled at ICC, you may live on campus in WoodView Commons. **NOTE:** You can have a Peoria mailing address and not be eligible; you can have a Dunlap or Edwards mailing address and be eligible. Go to <http://gis.peoriacounty.org/peoriapromise/> to verify address eligibility.

If you believe you have been incorrectly denied funding due to residency, you can submit an appeal to the Peoria Promise Foundation. All appeals must be mailed on or before **JUNE 1** to:

- Utility or rent bills
- Illinois Auto Registration Card
- Residential lease
- Statement of benefits history from the Illinois Department of Public Aid
- Statement of benefits history from the Illinois Department of Employment Security
- Statement of benefits from the Social Security Administration
- State or federal income tax return
- Wage and tax statements (IRS W-2 Forms)
- Illinois voter's registration card – must have a Date of Issue on it
- Property tax bill
- Illinois High School or College transcript showing attendance for the past three years
